

# Understanding Alternative Formats in ulearn



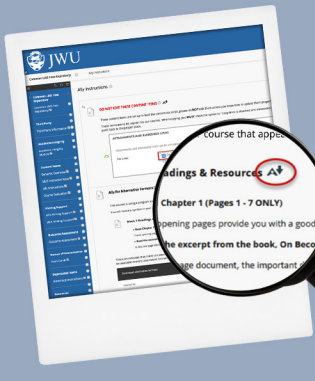
The **alternative formats feature** in ulearn allows you to access certain course materials and resources in a way that is most beneficial to you as a learner.

This creates a more engaging and user-friendly experience by enabling you to select a format that best supports your specific learning needs.



Reading, listening, using a screen reader, and electronic resources are all ways to access course material, and are available to you!

## How do I access alternative formats?



To access alternative formats in ulearn, simply click on the "A" (alternative formats icon) and select your desired format, then click download.



## Why access alternative formats?

Alternative formats support various learning styles and needs.

For example, you may download an audio version of your reading to listen to during a commute, or download an ePub version to read on a mobile device or tablet.

### Tagged PDF



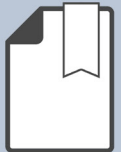
Well-suited for use with assistive technology

For viewing in the browser and on mobile devices.

### ePub



For reading as an e-Book or on an iPad and other e-Readers

### Electronic Braille



BRF version for consumption on electronic braille displays

### Audio



MP3 version for listening

### BeeLine Reader



Enhanced version for easier and faster on-screen reading

### Immersive Reader



Provides multiple options for increasing the readability of content
