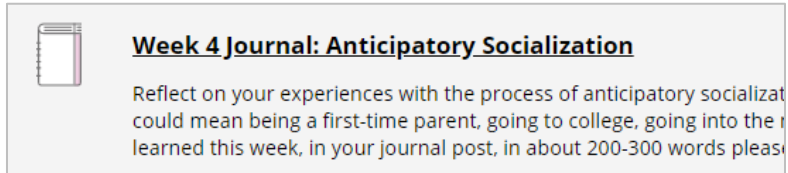



CREATE A JOURNAL ENTRY

As part of your course, the instructor may require you to create journal entries in order to reflect on a class, topic, or experience.

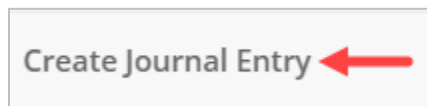
Instructions

1. Navigate to the journal assigned in the content area folder.

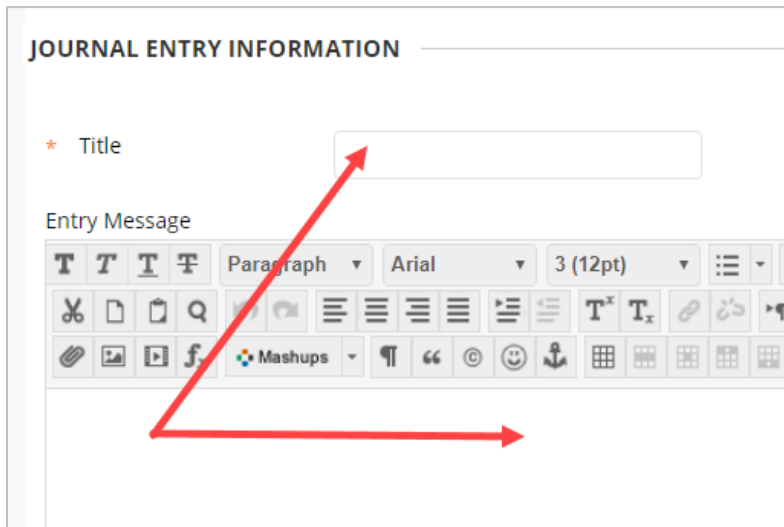


 **Week 4 Journal: Anticipatory Socialization**
